General Job Information

Eligibility:

Because this position is partly funded by the federal government's Canada Summer Jobs program, successful applicants must be:

- 30 years old or younger;
- and, hold a valid SIN number;
- and, be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or have refugee status.

Purpose of the position:

- Assist an experienced Everdale Gardener to maintain several Edible Gardens outside public buildings in Toronto
- Successful applicants will have at least two years of gardening experience

Start/End dates:

April/November

Pay:

- \$20.00/hr to 25.00/hr depending on experience; plus 4% vacation pay
- 30% off organic food from Everdale Farm

Hours per week:

- 10-15 hours/week
- Flexible; Monday to Friday.

Work location:

Several Toronto downtown and uptown locations. All accessible by public transit.

Job expectations:

- Have at least two years of gardening experience
- Perform general gardening tasks such as planting, weeding, irrigation, and harvesting.
- Communicate openly and respectfully with clients and the general public.
- Be punctual and ready to work selected hours.
- Be committed to working safely and efficiently.
- Able to lift up to 40 lbs.
- Able to perform physical, repetitive farming and gardening tasks.
- Able to work outside in a wide range of weather conditions.
- Able to consistently take a positive solution-based approach to challenges.
- Work occasional weekends and holidays, with notice.
