General Job Information

Eligibility:

Because this position is partly funded by the federal government's Canada Summer Jobs program, successful applicants must be:

- 30 years old or younger;
- and, hold a valid SIN number;
- and, be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or have refugee status.

Purpose of the position:

- Successful applicants will be trained to help maintain Everdale's forest/field trail system and perform basic construction work.
- Some previous experience with hand tools is an asset, plus a positive approach, a willingness to learn, and the ability to work outside Monday to Friday; 35 hours per week.

Start/end dates:

We are hiring for positions starting in late April and late June. When applying, please indicate which position you are applying for.

Pay:

- Between \$17.50/hour and \$19.00/hour depending on experience; plus 4% vacation pay
- 30% off all food items in Everdale's farm store

Hours per week:

- 35 hours/week
- Monday to Friday, during the day.

Work location:

- Everdale, 5812 Sixth Line, Hillsburgh, Ontario

- Perform basic maintenance of Everdale's trail system and help with small construction projects.
